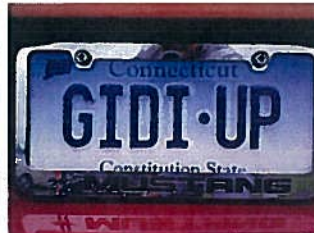
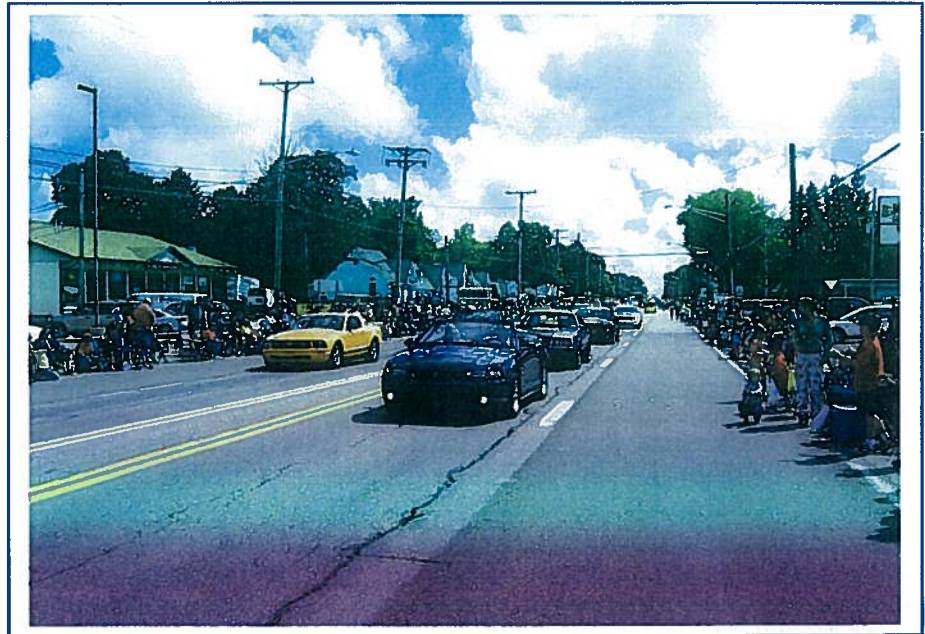

The MCA has requested a brief history from each Chartered Regional group. The following has been provided to the MCA for LEMOC.

The Lake Erie Mustang Owners Club (LEMOC) was founded in Erie, PA in 1983, with a focus on the preservation and enjoyment of all years and models of Ford and Shelby Mustangs. In 1986, LEMOC became a charter regional group of the Mustang Club of America.

The strength of LEMOC is our focus on family involvement and our common love for the Mustang hobby. We are currently supported by 70+ family memberships. Our monthly newsletter, "The Pony Post" keeps all members aware of club business and events, as well as other Mustang related news and activities.

LEMOC hosts and participates in numerous Mustang related activities, and coordinates various other club related activities for members. LEMOC's signature club event is our annual Mustang Round-Up. The first Round-Up was held in 1988, making 2008 our 20th annual all Mustang show. This show is traditionally held the first Sunday in August, with proceeds benefitting various local charitable organizations.

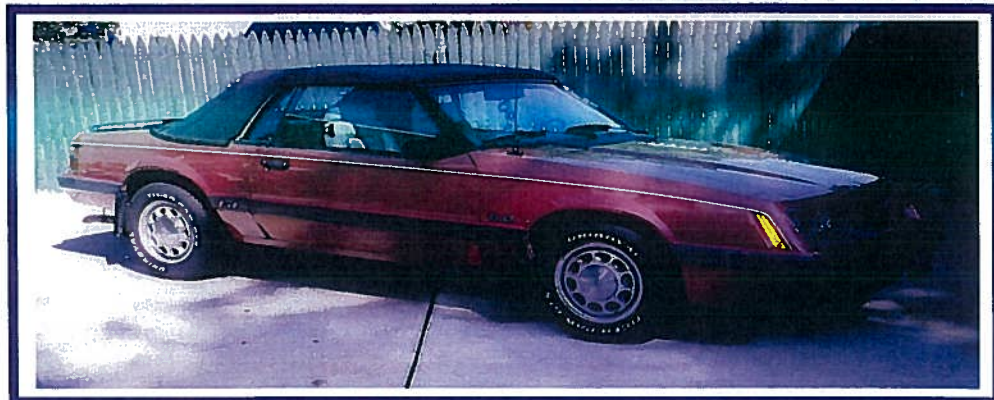
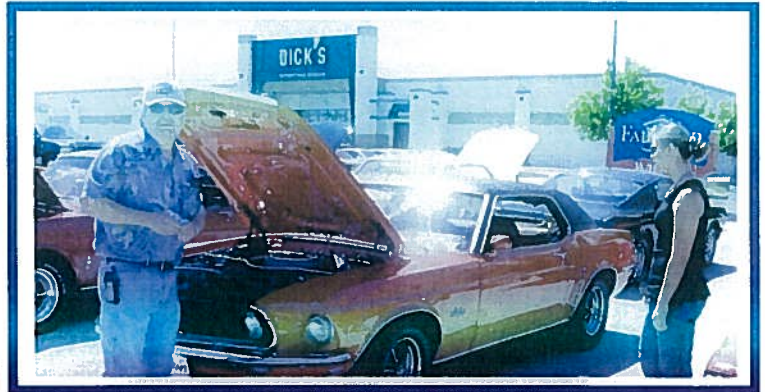

I also have an 86 GT convertible under construction, and an 85 LX convertible as a parts car. Four years ago, when I bought the 86 I thought 2 – 3 years to get it on the road. But

Kim is not a true car person, but she would like to have a 60's Co ... Cor ... Cor ... one of those Chevy sports cars. But, she bought the 85 Mustang for me several years ago for an anniversary present. That was with the idea that she would get the 86 when it was done.

I enjoy my membership in LEMOC and have made many friends. Kim and I really enjoy our club events and have had some memorable experiences with LEMOC.

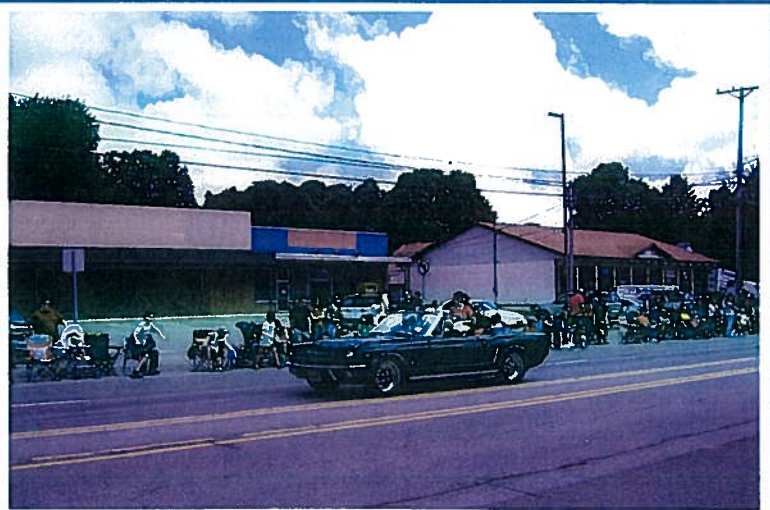

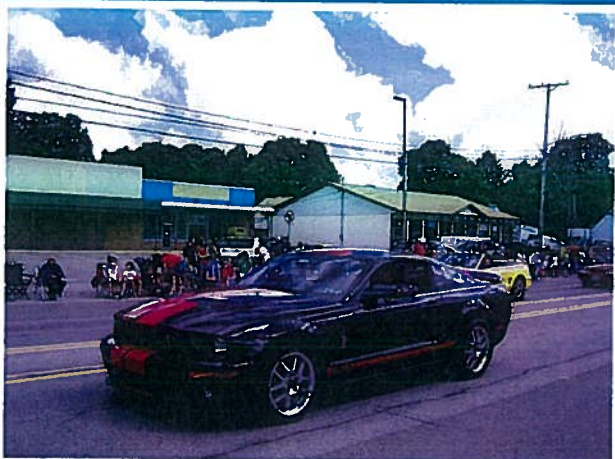
